Hunting investigations/incidents – any offence involving the illegal activity of coursing, hunting, poaching, and lamping

We are seeing increased tension between trail hunts and hunt monitors/saboteurs – we are reminded both sides of the need to remain lawful. This is taking significant Police resources currently upto 3 days a week.

1 Crime recorded – Public Order – Members of hunt on quadbikes sticking fingers up at a hunt monitor. No further action taken due to evidential difficulties.

Rural investigations/incidents – any offence involving the damage or loss to agriculture, its practices and the rural working environment

- **22/9 Casitor St Edmund –** Padlocks removed from gates and sheep moved to another field for unknown reasons
- 23/9 Hethersett Theft of Orange Fuel Bowser (single axle) with 1000 litre diesel
- 25/9 A140 Long Stratton 650 litres diesel stolen from bowser on site and dumper truck.
- **25/9 Holme Hale –** Shed/Office broken into a McCormick tractor with grass topper on back stolen along with tri axle Ifor Williams trailer.
- **24/9 Downham Market –** Vehicles driven on football pitch causing damage

Wildlife investigations/incidents – any offences which contravenes current legislation governing the protection of wild animals, plants and domesticated animals

21/9 – Hopton – Dogs Worrying Livestock – Dog has entered a garden/paddock causing harm to chickens and goats.

27/9 – Matlaske – Cat has been shot in the leg with an air weapon
