

OP Randall Weekly Update

Period Covered –

Sunday 6th November – Sunday 13th November (*please note some crimes are reported many days after the event hence some falling outside of date range)

Hunting investigations/incidents – any offence involving the illegal activity of coursing, hunting, poaching, and laming

5/11 – Hackford (Wymondham) – Report of 2 deer carcasses (fully butchered) dumped in a dry pond in middle of a field. Suspected poaching.

7/11 Ringstead (Hunstanton) – Possible hare coursing involving a blue Ford Connect van

Rural investigations/incidents – any offence involving the damage or loss to agriculture, its practices and the rural working environment

30/9 - West Rudham (Kings Lynn) – 2 Tractors and tank syphoned 1510 litres of red diesel stolen

6/11 – Rackheath (Norwich) – White HGV involved in breaking into a industrial unit stealing 2000 litres of diesel.

6/11 – Kirby Cane (South Norfolk) – Vehicle broken into a number of Makita tools stolen

7/11 – Bale (North Norfolk) - Builders yard broken into a number of tools stolen

7/11 – Kings Lynn Area – A number of premises (5) had cooking oil stolen from, 2 people arrested.

7/11 – Witleingham – Metal field gate, Metal 1100litre wheelie bin and memorial tree stolen further crime of a wooden gate also stolen in area.

8/11 – Hoveton – Fishing and camera gear stolen from a vehicle in a car park

10/11 – Brancaster Staithe (Kings Lynn) – Outboard motor stolen from a boat

12/11 – Necton (Swaffham) – At a farm numerous buildings entered a pressure washer and diesel has been stolen

12/11 – Hillington (Kings Lynn) – Pheasant release pen damaged overnight

Wildlife/Animal Welfare investigations/incidents – any offences which contravenes current legislation governing the protection of wild animals, plants and domesticated animals

4/11-6/11 - Great Witchingham (Broadland) – Report of 2 terrier dogs chasing/penning sheep in a field

7/11 – Norwich – Male seen to run over pigeon in mobility scooter causing suffering

Heritage investigations/incidents – any offences involving damage or loss to the historic environment

7/11 – Ludham – A number of holes dug on protected land consistent with illegal metal detecting.

Any other business

7/11 – South Creake – Quad, Livestock Trailer, Small Motorbike and other garden type tools stolen. Recovered very quickly by Lincolnshire colleagues! Lots of ongoing work with this one.
