Hunting investigations/incidents – any offence involving the illegal activity of coursing, hunting, poaching, and lamping

Rural investigations/incidents – any offence involving the damage or loss to agriculture, its practices and the rural working environment

12/11 – East Bilney (Dereham) – 1000 litres of heating oil stolen

13/11 – Upwell (Kings Lynn) – Shed broken into, Segway A2 Quad 248 Stolen '22 plated

13/11 – Worstead (North Norfolk) – Haulage yard broken into attempted to steal red diesel (none stolen)

13/11 – Potter Heigham – Arson hay bales set a light

14/11 – Thetford – Van broken into number of tools stolen (another crime same night similar circs)

14/11 – Wymondham – 360 mini digger, lfor Williams trailer and other items stolen from outside address

14/11 – Surlingham (South Norfolk) – 15 Chainsaw and climbing equipment taken from shipping container

14/11 – Shotesham (South Norfolk) – Trailer stolen from yard

14/11 – Kings Lynn – Multiple garden tools stolen from a building

14/11 – Wighton (Kings Lynn) – Multiple power tools stolen from a site compound

14/11 – Geldeston (South Norfolk) – Power tools stolen from unlocked shed

15/11 – Thorpe St Andrew (Norwich) – power tools stolen from garage

15/11 – Terrington St Clement (West Norfolk) – power tools stolen from a secure shipping container

15/11 – Long Stratton – power tools stolen from van

15/11 – Wiggenhall – John Deere mower stolen from shed

16/11 – Salthouse (North Norfolk) – Power tools stolen from building site

16/11 – Tasburgh (South Norfolk) – van broken into hedge trimmer stolen

17/11 – Holt – Electric fence equipment has been stolen

17/11 – Mulbarton (South Norfolk) – Vehicle broken into tools taken

18/11 – Terrington St John (West Norfolk) – broken into a shed, have attempted to steal quadbike. **Due to chain anchor they have failed!**

18/11 – Foulden (Breckland) – Forestry vehicles entered 2000litres of diesel stolen along with tools.

18/11 – Little Cressingham (North Norfolk) – Office has been entered multiple power tools stolen.

21/11 – Upwell (Kings Lynn) – 200 litres of heating oil stolen

22/11 – Weston Longville (Broadland) – theft of red diesel

24/11 – Shernborne (Kings Lynn) – Red diesel removed from tractors (small amount)

Wildlife/Animal investigations/incidents – any offences which contravenes current legislation governing the protection of wild animals, plants and domesticated animals

19/11 – Tilney All Saints (West Norfolk) – Ram has been stolen from a field

Heritage investigations/incidents – any offences involving damage or loss to the historic environment

13/11 – Stowbridge – Broken windows in a church

14/11 – Watlington – Lead roof attempted to be stolen from church

24/11 – Little Walsingham – 2 People reported nighthawking (using metal detector on land without permission)

Any other business

20/11 – West Raynham (Fakenham) – Officers called to reports of loud music, Unlicensed Music Event found in a barn with no permission from land owner, equipment seized by Police.

It is clear tools are a target currently, which is often a trend this time of year. Where possible remove tools from vehicles, chain them all together with some chain, consider alarms CCTV etc. also make sure they are marked with engraving or permanent pen with postcode atleast.
