Hunting investigations/incidents – any offence involving the illegal activity of coursing, hunting, poaching, and lamping

30/11 – Outwell – Hare coursing reported in blue Suzuki number plate ending 'RVW'

01/12 – Outwell – Hare coursing reported in Cambs, vehicle stopped in Norfolk and 4 individuals issued Community Protection Warnings – vehicle a red Subaru Forester number plate ending 'OUG'

Rural investigations/incidents – any offence involving the damage or loss to agriculture, its practices and the rural working environment

24/11 – Great Ellingham – Topcon Monitor removed from tractor

24/11 – Winfarthing (Diss) – tipping trailer stolen from driveway – trailer recovered in Suffolk in disused barn

25/11 – Burgh (Broadland) – Stihl chainsaw stolen from a vehicle

24/11 – Shouldham Thorpe (Kings Lynn) – garage broken into chain saw stolen

24/11 – Wood Norton (North Norfolk) – 900 litres of heating oil stolen

24/11 – Hapton (South Norfolk) – 150 electric fencing stakes stolen perimeter of field

25/11 – Great Witchingham – Theft of electric fencing unit and battery

27/11 – Blakeney – Outbuilding broke into John Deere sit on lawn mower and 2 strimmer's stolen

27/11 – Coston (South Norfolk) – Honda Quadbike stolen from open yard building

28/11 – Marsham (Broadland) – GPS systems stolen from tractors

28/11 – Upton (Broadland) – 2.5 tonne trailer stolen – NR Postcode stamped near the front of trailer

28/11 – Great Massingham – shed broken into multiple Stihl tools stolen

28/11 – Thursford – three overboard boat engines stolen, stamped with owners surname and postcode

28/11 – Hingham (South Norfolk) – tools stolen from vehicle

28/11 – Little Cressingham (Breckland) – metal containers forced open tools stolen

28/11 – Wroxham – Multiple GPS systems stolen

28/11 – Salhouse – Multiple GPS systems stolen and red diesel

28/11 – Frettenham – GPS System stolen from tractor

29/11 – Sheringham – vehicle broken into multiple tools stolen

29/11 – Norton Subcourse (South Norfolk – sheds broken into a chainsaw stolen

30/11 – Foulden (Thetford) – suspects enter yard, damage caused and camera stolen

1/12 – Shropham (Watton) – 60 bales of chopped straw stolen and 2 petrol generators

3/12 – Terrington St John (Wisbech) – Kubota midi tractor stolen from barn

Wildlife/Animal investigations/incidents – any offences which contravenes current legislation governing the protection of wild animals, plants and domesticated animals

Heritage investigations/incidents – any offences involving damage or loss to the historic environment

Any other business

30/11 – Stolen digger (From 2016) seized in Norfolk and returned to owner in Oxford after found with all identifiers removed apart from DataTag identifiers – again showing the power of this initiative.

We have seen a number of GPS systems stolen from tractors in the past week, this follows a similar increase in Suffolk and across the country. Please remove the systems if they are currently not being used, make sure they are marked with postcode and surname too.
