Weekly Update Week Ending 15th January 2023

Hunting investigations/incidents – any offence involving the illegal activity of coursing, hunting, poaching, and laming

12/1 – Edgebank, Emneth – Hare coursing reported (limited details)

14/1 – Friday Bridge, Wisbech – Hare coursing reported (limited details – dealt with by Cambs)

15/1 – Tilney St Lawrence – Hare Coursing reported involving a grey Suzuki Vitara GU05EYS, left the area by time Police arrived.

Rural investigations/incidents – any offence involving the damage or loss to agriculture, its practices and the rural working environment, alongside rural community.

6/1 – Halvergate (Norwich) – Childs quadbike stolen from garden shed

6/1 – Brundall (Broadland) – building site broken into a rake cultivator stolen and BCS 750 power unit

7/1 – Gorleston – Building site entered 6 shipping containers broken into multiple tools stolen, also forklift on site 'hot wired' to assist breaking into containers.

7/1 – Feltwell – Theft of heating oil

8/1 – Dilham (North Walsham) – Shed entered and 2 chainsaws stolen

9/1 – Lyng (Dereham) – Small amount of scrap metal has been stolen from a private yard

10/1 – Weeting (Thetford) – Agricultural sheds broken into, diesel and small farm equipment stolen

10/1 – Weeting (Thetford) – 1.5ton Peter Allen Field Dispenser (pig feeder) stolen from land

10/1 – Keswick (South Norfolk) – Diesel siphoned from small excavator

12/1 – Docking (Kings Lynn) – Farm building broken into a tools stolen.

13/1 – Hemsby – Small heater stolen from church
