Weekly Update Week Ending 12th of February 2023

Hunting investigations/incidents – any offence involving the illegal activity of coursing, hunting, poaching, and laming

12/2 – Bradenham (Watton) – 4 men stopped with lurchers and under investigation for going equipped to hare course. Vehicle seized.

Rural investigations/incidents – any offence involving the damage or loss to agriculture, its practices and the rural working environment, alongside rural community.

31/1 – Gissing (Diss) – Red diesel stolen from a bowser stored in a heavy plant site

2/2 – Methwold – attempt to steal heating oil from public building

2/2 – East Walton (Kings Lynn) – damage to a cropped field by vehicle suspected from hare coursing

3/2 – Dersingham (Kings Lynn) – horse jump rail stolen

5/2 – Ketteringham (Wymondham) – Storage shed broken into ride on mower, tools and fishing equipment stolen

5/2 – Woodton (Long Stratton) – Off the lead dog walker abused victim after asking dog put on lead around cattle

6/2 – Bodney (Thetford) – 4 tool boxes on tractors broken into and tools stolen

7/2 – Welney – 3 Batteries stolen from back garden

9/2 – Wretton (Kings Lynn) – Sheep feed and water troughs stolen as well as mineral licks

11/2 – Long Stratton – Chicken pens deliberately opened and damaged

Wildlife/Animal investigations/incidents – any offences which contravenes current legislation governing the protection of wild animals, plants and domesticated animals

9/2 – Hilgay (Downham Market) – Badger sett disturbance and destruction (2 offences at same location)

Heritage investigations/incidents – any offences involving damage or loss to the historic environment

27/1 – Wymondham – stained glass window at church broken along with fencing being pulled down.

7/2 – Runham (Great Yarmouth) – entry forced to an old wild pump and damage caused inside
