A former England rugby star turned Norfolk farmer. Tom who originally played for the Leicester Tigers, returned home when he retired from Rugby to take over from his father and Uncles farm alongside his cousin George and now the two run the farm together. The family farms 1,900 acres, of which about 1,000 acres is owned and the rest is contracted. It is predominantly arable, but they also keep around 80 free-range pigs in the woodland, butchered locally and sold through farm shops and restaurants under the Youngs Farm Produce brand. And this year the pair won the coveted Norfolk Farm Business competition.
